Prizes

- First prize: Your photo on the cover of our 2011 calendar, US\$500 (or equivalent in your preferred currency), and five copies of the calendar.
- Runners-up: Your photo featured on one of the inside calendar months (13 available), US\$100 (or equivalent in your preferred currency), and five copies of the calendar.

Photo requirements

- Photos must be of a performing arts building that Theatre Projects has worked on.
- Photos can be of anywhere in the theatre – front of house spaces, support spaces, outdoor spaces, classrooms, theatres, backstage...
- Files must be digital and should be a minimum 8" x 10" at 300dpi (or 2400 x 3000 pixels), saved as jpegs (.jpg), in RGB format.
- No signature, stamp, or any other identifying mark is allowed anywhere on the entry.

How to submit your photo

- Fill in an entry form with info about you and your photo. If you're submitting more than one photo, complete an entry form for each photo.
- Email your entry form(s) and photo(s) to photos@theatreprojects.com.

- Deadline for submissions: Monday, August 30, 2010, 5pm GMT
- Winners announced: on or before Wednesday, September 1, 2010
